The **simple predicate** is the main verb or verb phrase in the complete predicate. A **simple predicate** is made up of at least one verb.

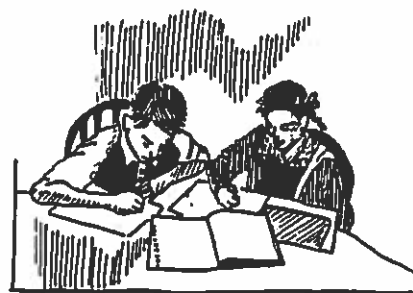

A **sentence fragment** is a group of words without a subject or predicate or both. A **run-on sentence** is two or more sentences that are run together into one sentence.
