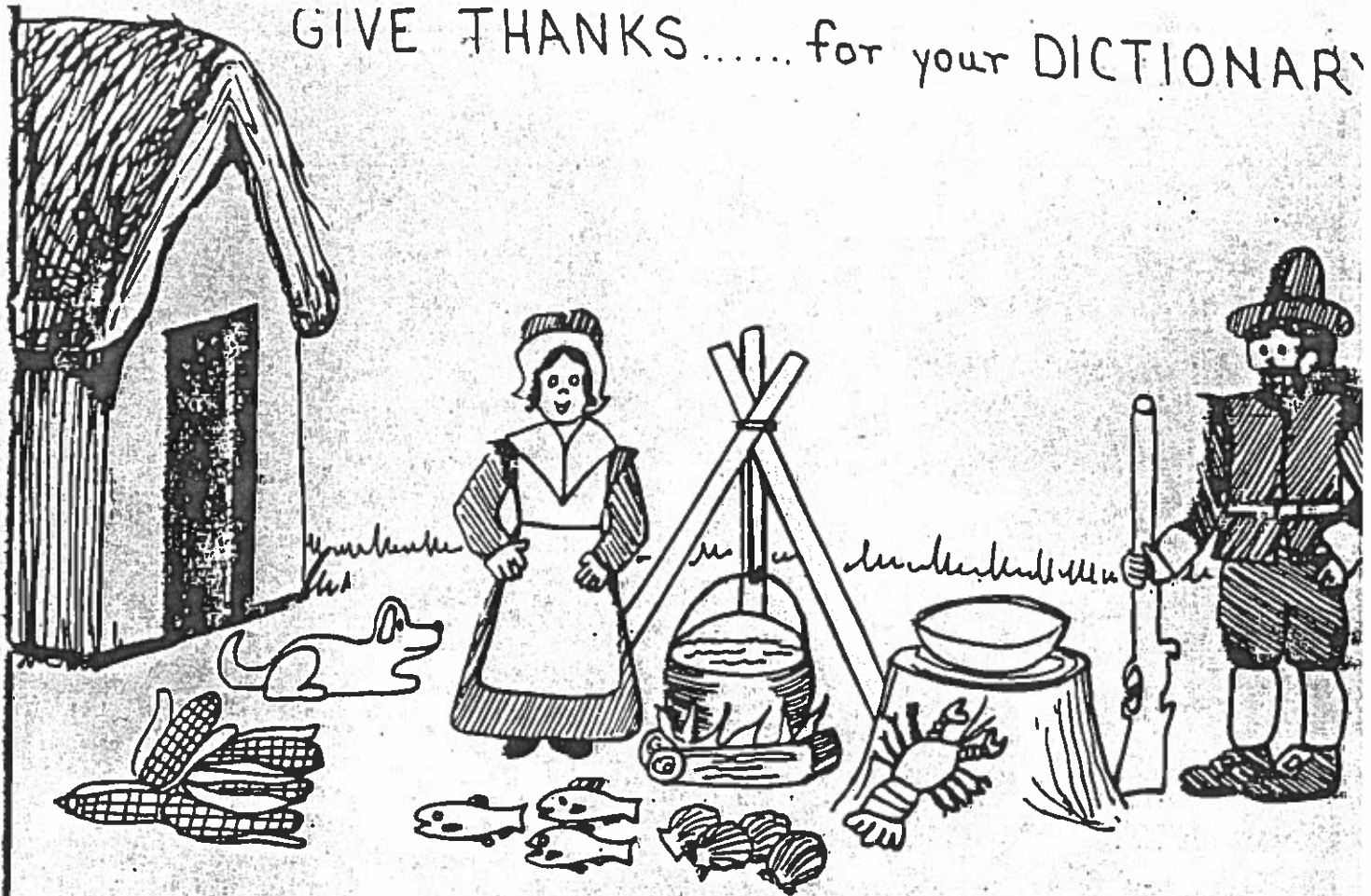


GIVE THANKS..... for your DICTIONARY
