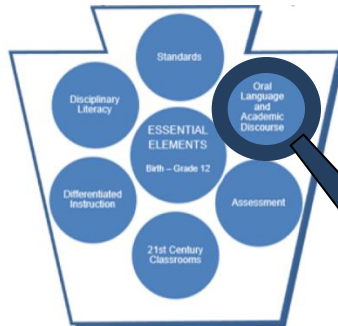

CDTs

The new CDT Diagnostic Category (DC) tests are now available as part of a single CDT administration, both the Full CDT and the DC tests are now utilizing the enhanced Interactive Reporting tool.

District users will be able to generate district student data files on-demand through DRC's Interactive Reporting System later this fall. This new functionality will replace the static data files that were posted on the INSIGHT Portal four times per administration and will provide greater flexibility for district level users who utilize the data and benefit from the most current data.
