Accommodations

Accommodations are practices and procedures that ensure that educators, as well as students and parents, have a valid measure of what students with disabilities know and can do. In addition, students with IEPs, 504 plans, and ESL plans may be provided with assessment accommodations.

Accommodations do not reduce expectations for learning. Accommodations provided to a student during state assessments must also be provided during classroom instruction, classroom assessments, and district assessments. However, some instructional accommodations may not be appropriate for use on certain statewide assessments. It is critical that educators become familiar with state policies about the appropriate use of accommodations during assessments.

Unpacking/Deconstructing the Standards

What does it mean to unpack or deconstruct the standards?

- What are the grade level standards my students should know and be able to demonstrate?

- What is the academic/domain-specific vocabulary and what does it mean for my grade level?

- What does the teacher need to know, do/consider for students to demonstrate proficiency?

In a recent professional development session with Dr. Jeri Thompson, we discussed the backward design process in relation to instruction.

Backward Design Process

- What are the grade level standards my students should know and be able to demonstrate? What does the standard mean?
- Where is the standard embedded in my curricular units ensuring access and Which texts will students read that will exemplify the expectations of the standards?
- How will I teach students the expectations of the standards?
 - How will I ensure that students have ample opportunities to learn and practice the expectations of the standards?

Deconstruction Process Identify standard assessed

- Explain what teachers need to know (that is not explicitly identified in the standard) for student success
- Identify the instructional implications
 - o Teacher focus
 - Student demonstration
