

Instruction & Assessment Accommodations to Meet Individual Student Needs



The goal of this course is to increase educators' understanding of the purpose and use of accommodations that can be used to help a student access academic content. Occasionally, a student that has not yet been identified as needing special services requires an accommodation for both instruction and assessment. This course also examines the types of accommodations that

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may be helpful to a student as provided by general educators, special educators, EL educators, and educators in support roles such as guidance counselors and administrators. Documentation must be kept in a student's record regarding the need for an accommodation for both instruction and assessment. This module provides 5 Act 48 hours.
